Dr. Carlito Calil Junior (Brazil)

Graduated in Civil Engineering from the School of Engineering in Piracicaba (1975), Master in Structural Engineering from the University of São Paulo (1978) and Doctor in Industrial Engineering from the Polytechnic University of Catalonia (1982). He did post-doctorate at the University of Karlsruhe, Germany, University of Twente, the Netherlands and at the Forest Products Laboratory of Madison, United States. He is currently Senior Professor at the São Carlos School of Engineering at the University of São Paulo. He has vast experience in the area of structural civil engineering, especially with: silos, wooden bridges, wooden structures and prestressed. He has participated in the elaboration of Brazilian norms, especially in norms of wood structures, silos, actions, wind and bridges. He is Coordinator of the Commission of Studies CE 02: 126.10 of the Brazilian Association of Technical Standards ABNT and founding member of the Brazilian Institute of Wood and Wood Structures. He is a representative of Brazil in the International Association of Wood Products Societies (IAWPS) Japan, in the International Association for Bridge and Structural Engineering USA and in the Ibero-Latin American Commission of timber construction. He trained 29 doctors and 28 master's degrees.

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
